

Guided Backpacking:

This service is designed for persons or groups who enjoy the security of hiking with an experienced trip guide. Groups or individuals provide all their own equipment, camping gear, sleeping bags, cook gear and groceries for the trip. Your guide comes self-sufficient with his/her own gear ready to go! Your guide provides knowledge of the specific area both on and off trails, will demonstrate and utilize low impact camping techniques and will provide area interpretation. Specific itineraries are pre-planned based upon your ability level and expectations. Number of days can vary and group size limitations will conform to Forest Service regulations.

Reservations

Trip reservations may be made by telephone, fax or e-mail. A 50% deposit is required to confirm your dates. If this is not received within 7 working days, your dates will then become available on a first come, first serve basis. Payments may be made in the form of cashier's check, money order, VISA, Mastercard or Discover. Personal checks must be pre-approved. Your balance will be payable prior to or upon arrival in Challis.

Rates Do Not Include

- Cost of fishing license (steelhead tag)
- 6% state sales tax
- All travel costs to and from trailhead
- Motel lodging and meals before and after trip dates
- Optional donation \$1/day/person to Idaho Outfitters & Guides Association

Confirmation Packet

Upon receipt of your trip deposit, a complete contract package will be sent to you for completion and

your signature. The contract specifically describes the service you have purchased, the dates, what is included, what is not included, the price, the deposit made and balance due. Also included is a trip registration form which includes questions regarding your health. This must be completed in order to participate. Also included is an acknowledgment of risk form. A specific list of what-to-bring for that activity will also be included.

Fishing Licenses

If you are planning to fish while on any trip, you must purchase an Idaho fishing license and carry this on your person while doing so. This is your responsibility and may be purchased locally from a number of vendors. If you have any questions regarding cost, please contact us.

Cancellation Policy

Due to the compressed nature of our spring/summer seasons of operation, we are not able to refund deposits or final payments. But, we do understand that emergencies can occur. In such cases, we will refund your deposit if you cancel by phone or e-mail 90-days in advance of your trip dates. **No refund shall be made on trips confirmed or cancelled with less than 90-days notice.** However, in either case you have the option to transfer your deposit and trip commitment to another party. If you are concerned about the possibility of having to cancel your trip, we suggest that you purchase trip cancellation insurance. Check with your local travel agent. This will ensure that you do not forfeit any monies you have paid to White Cloud Outfitters.

Liability, Safety And Your Responsibilities

We make every effort to ensure that your trip is enjoyable and safe. Your guide will give you instructions before and during your trip. It is important that you listen and follow these instructions. During your trip, you will assume the responsibility for many decisions that could affect your safety. Some activities can be physically demanding with inherent elements of risk that are beyond our control. White Cloud Outfitters is not a medical facility. Hospital facilities are not readily available. (An

emergency clinic is available in Challis and Stanley). But, evacuation can be prolonged, difficult and expensive. We do not assume liability for personal injury or death. All participation is at your own risk. Different types of trips require varying degrees of fitness. We are not qualified to evaluate your fitness regarding your participation in the activities we offer. If you are overweight or in poor physical health or condition, you should consult your physician before booking your trip.

Fly Fishing for Spring Steelhead or Summer Rainbow Trout:

We are licensed to fish three stretches of the Main Salmon River from Torrey's Boat launch to North Fork, Idaho. Spring steelhead fishing begins in March and runs through mid to late April. Summer rainbow fishing by drift boat can be booked late June through August. Both trips are booked by the day with our drift boats accommodating two fishermen plus your guide. We'll assist with lodging arrangements in Challis for the spring steelhead season. We provide 8 wt. fly rods/reels, flies, tackle, life jackets, experienced fly fishing guide/boatman, shuttle, hearty lunch and beverages.

Summer Chinook Salmon Fishing:

July is the month for the Kings to return to the Upper Salmon River! We offer guided drift boat fishing for all ages and abilities! These silvery 15-plus pound fighters are what the Salmon River is known for! We can also prepare and freeze your catch for the trip home - check pricing. We book trips by the day and we'll assist with lodging arrangements in Challis. White Cloud Outfitters provides specialized rods, reels, bait, tackle, ice, hearty lunch, beverages, life jackets and experienced guide and shuttle.

Salmon River Day Float:

This family float is a good introduction to the mighty Salmon River. The upper river is a calm float with plenty of trout fishing opportunities if you choose to bring a rod. This day float may vary as to put-in and take-out location due to water levels. Inflatable rafts carry groups of 6 to 8 guests (not including your licensed boatman). Day floats include a scrumptious riverside feast, USCG approved life jackets and vehicle shuttle. Family/group discounts available. Seniors welcome.

Guided Mt. Lake/Stream Fly Fishing for Hikers

Hike with your guide into local Mountain Lakes in the White Cloud Range for a day of Lake and/or stream fly-fishing. We provide lunch, fishing expertise and hand-tied flies for a successful day of "matching the hatch." You provide your rod/reel, waders, wading shoes, day pack and we do the rest. You need to be prepared for a moderate hike and you can expect to be fishing anywhere from 6,200 to 8,500 feet in elevation.

Roving Horseback Pack Trips:

Our extended guided horseback trips are designed so guests can really experience the White Clouds Wilderness. These trips move camp every other day with layover days allowing time to relax, fish or day-hike. You'll be able to photograph the wildlife, identify the alpine flora and relax next to a high mountain lake while spectacular scenery surrounds you. Meals are prepared fresh, horses are gentle, guides are friendly and knowledgeable and all equipment is provided except your personal gear and sleeping bag. Dates are scheduled on a first come first serve basis from July through September. Exact destinations and travel route will vary depending upon length of trip.

5-Day Combination Packtrip/Scenic Float:

This custom trip offers the best of everything! After arriving in Challis, the following day we will first schedule a guided/catered three-day pack trip into our base camp, right under Castle Peak. From here you will have the opportunity to take photos, enjoy the scenery, view wildlife and do some fishing in one of the nearby alpine lake chains. After enjoying two nights in our comfortable camp, we will depart the high country for Challis and the Salmon River. The next day, you will launch on the famous River of No Return for a two-day catered float with your experienced boatman/guide. All of your riverside camping gear will be provided except your

sleeping bag. This is a great combination trip especially for those new to the area!

Multi-day Base Camp Adventure Fishing or Photography:

This multi-day mountain lake fly fishing trip begins with a guided horseback ride into your reserved camp located in the heart of the White Cloud Wilderness. Your cozy camp will consist of 14x16 sleep tents complete with wood stoves and comfortable cots with four (4) inch foams. All meals are served family-style. Our covered kitchen is completely set-up with propane stoves, bar-b-que facility and wash up area. We bring all the fresh essentials and more to offer a variety of scrumptious grilled entrées while you concentrate your efforts on "matching the hatch." Our knowledgeable fly fishing guides will also instruct you on techniques if you are new to the sport. If more photographic opportunity is what you're looking for or just a change of scenery, you may choose to hike to one of several other lakes in the immediate area, too.

Spot-Pack or Drop Camp For Backpackers:

This service offers avid backpackers and hikers the freedom of experiencing the backcountry on their own and without the added weight of a heavy pack. This service is for hikers somewhat familiar with the country with their own itinerary already in mind. You decide where you want your gear dropped off and we do the rest. We meet you and your gear at the trailhead, pack-up your equipment and transport it by horseback to your campsite. We then return at a prearranged date and time to pack your gear out of the backcountry. You may also choose to ride into or out of your destination. Cost is based upon the number of horses used regardless of whether they are ridden or packed.

Full-Day Ride In Challis Valley:

For those with less time to spend in the Idaho backcountry, we offer a full day ride out of the Challis Valley. Specific routes vary and may be chosen depending upon photographic, historic, or wildlife interests. Departure time from our ranch is 10:00 a.m. with arrival back at 4:00 p.m. A hearty lunch and beverages are provided. Children are welcome with a minimum age of 8 years.

Multi-Day Float Trips:

This leisurely float trip is for those who would like to spend more than just a day on the famous "River of No Return." Since we are licensed to over 120 miles of the Salmon River we have lots of options regarding launch sites, camp sites and take-out locations. We can put together anything from a family overnight to a five day extended fishing trip! The meals consist of "riverside grill" cuisine, which includes our famous Dutch oven deserts. We provide all the necessary camping equipment and have sleeping bags available to rent. Children and seniors are always welcome.

Wild Horse Viewing Or White Cloud Day Ride:

This historic day-ride opportunity will take you back to a time when the West was still unsettled and when wild horses still roamed free. Today, a free-ranging herd of about 300 animals, makes its home in the low rolling hills outside Challis. This herd is managed by the Bureau of Land Management and offers an excellent viewing opportunity from horseback. Departure points vary and scheduling is flexible. Lunch is included and advance reservations are necessary.
